

WIN A BYD SEALION 7 LUCKY DRAW

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These terms and conditions (the “**T&Cs**”) apply to the “Win a BYD Sealion 7 Lucky Draw” conducted in connection with the 2026 BYD Singapore International Marathon presented by adidas (the “**Lucky Draw**”). By participating in the Lucky Draw, each participant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions.

The Lucky Draw is subject to all applicable laws and regulations in Singapore.

1. ORGANISER

- 1.1. The Lucky Draw is organised and administered by SG International Marathon Pte. Ltd. (UEN: 202538478G), a company incorporated under the laws of Singapore and having its registered office at 12 Kallang Avenue, #03-25, Aperia, Singapore 339511 (the “**Organiser**”).
- 1.2. The sponsor for the Lucky Draw is BYD (Singapore) Pte. Ltd. (UEN: 201409518W), a company incorporated under the laws of Singapore and having its registered office at 151 Lorong Chuan, #04-03B, New Tech Park, Singapore 556741 (the “**Sponsor**”).

2. PROMOTION PERIOD

- 2.1. The Lucky Draw promotion period shall commence on 27 April 2026 and end on 30 September 2026, both dates inclusive (the “**Promotion Period**”).
- 2.2. The Organiser holds sole discretion in extending the Promotion Period beyond 30 September 2026. In this situation, the Lucky Draw promotion period shall similarly be extended (the “**Extended Promotion Period**”) to reflect the new end date.
- 2.3. Only eligible entries successfully recorded in the Organiser’s systems during the Promotion Period shall qualify for the Lucky Draw.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1. Participation in the Lucky Draw is only open to registered participants of the 2026 BYD Singapore International Marathon presented by adidas.
- 3.2. To qualify for the Lucky Draw, the participant’s race registration must be valid, successful and not cancelled, refunded, reversed or voided, whether in whole or in part.
- 3.3. The following persons are not eligible to participate in the Lucky Draw:
 - (a) participants of the Professional Field and EFGH National Championships;
 - (b) participants of any race categories who are employees of any of the following entities:
 - (i) the Organiser;
 - (ii) Sport Singapore;

- (iii) Singapore Tourism Board;
- (iv) Singapore Athletic Association;
- (v) BYD (Singapore) Pte. Ltd.; or
- (vi) BYD Company Limited;
- (c) participants who registered under International Registration as international applicants and are not ordinarily resident in Singapore; and
- (d) such other persons as the Organiser may determine to be ineligible due to conflict of interest, regulatory requirements or operational requirements.

For the avoidance of doubt, a participant is “ordinarily resident” in Singapore if the participant is (a) a Singapore citizen, (b) a Singapore Permanent Resident, or (c) a valid holder of an Employment Pass, Work Permit or Dependent Pass.

- 3.4. Where a participant is under eighteen (18) years of age, the participant must have the consent of his or her parent or legal guardian to participate in the Lucky Draw. The parent or legal guardian shall act on behalf of the participant in connection with the acceptance of the Prize, execution of required documents and compliance with these T&Cs.
- 3.5. The Organiser may require documentary evidence of the parent-child or legal guardianship relationship, including identification documents, birth certificates, guardianship orders or other documents reasonably required by the Organiser. If such documents are not provided within the stipulated timeframe, or if the Organiser is not satisfied as to the relationship or legal guardianship, the Organiser may deem the participant ineligible, disqualify the participant or forfeit the Prize.
- 3.6. The Organiser reserves the right to verify the eligibility of any participant and to disqualify any participant who does not comply with these terms and conditions.

4. ENTRY MECHANICS

- 4.1. Each eligible registered participant and holder of a bib in any of the following race categories shall be entitled to two (2) eligible entries per bib into the Lucky Draw:
 - (a) BYD Marathon; and
 - (b) Crew Challenge.
- 4.2. Each eligible registered participant and holder of a bib in any of the following race categories shall be entitled to one (1) eligible entry per bib into the Lucky Draw:
 - (a) Kids Dash;
 - (b) 5km;
 - (c) Standard Chartered 10km; and
 - (d) adidas Half Marathon.
- 4.3. If the BYD Singapore International Marathon presented by adidas — RunFlex (“**RunFlex**”) service is used, and a participant cancels his or her race entry by 27 November 2026 and receives a

refund in accordance with the applicable RunFlex terms, the relevant bib shall be voided, and all Lucky Draw entries associated with that bib shall be withdrawn.

- 4.4. Entries are not transferable and may not be sold, assigned or exchanged.
- 4.5. The Organiser reserves the right to determine, verify and validate all qualifying registrations, transactions and entries at its sole discretion.

5. DRAW MECHANICS

- 5.1. The Lucky Draw shall be conducted by the Organiser between 30 November 2026 and 2 December 2026, or on such other date as may be determined by the Organiser.
- 5.2. The winner of the Lucky Draw (the “**Winner**”) shall be selected at random from all eligible entries received during the Promotion Period.
- 5.3. The Lucky Draw shall be conducted in the presence of a Notary Public, or such other scrutineer as may be required under applicable law or regulatory requirements.
- 5.4. The Organiser’s decision on all matters relating to the Lucky Draw, including eligibility, entries, winner selection and prize award, shall be final and binding.

6. WINNER NOTIFICATION AND ACCEPTANCE

- 6.1. The Winner shall be notified by the Organiser between 30 November 2026 and 2 December 2026, or such other period as may be determined by the Organiser, through one or more of the following methods:
 - (a) the Organiser’s official mobile number at +65 [9799 7361];
 - (b) the Organiser’s official email at marketing@singaporeinternationalmarathon.com;
 - (c) SMS from the Organiser’s official mobile number at +65 [9799 7361]; and/or
 - (d) such other means as the Organiser may determine.
- 6.2. The Winner must confirm acceptance of the prize within twenty-four (24) hours of the first attempt at being contacted by the Organiser, or such other period as may be specified by the Organiser.
- 6.3. If the Winner:
 - (a) cannot be contacted;
 - (b) does not respond within the stipulated time;
 - (c) does not accept the prize within the stipulated time;
 - (d) is found to be ineligible;
 - (e) fails to provide the documents or information required for verification or prize fulfilment; or
 - (f) fails to comply with these terms and conditions,the Organiser and/or the Sponsor may forfeit the prize.

- 6.4. If the prize is forfeited, the Organiser may award the prize to a replacement winner selected by another draw from the remaining eligible entries (the “**Subsequent Draw**”). For the avoidance of doubt, the Subsequent Draw will be conducted in accordance with Clause 5.
- 6.5. The Winner may be required to attend a prize presentation ceremony on or around 6 December 2026, or on such other date and at such location as may be notified by the Organiser. The actual collection of the Prize (as defined below) shall be arranged separately between the Winner and the Sponsor. If the Winner is unable or unwilling to attend the prize presentation ceremony (if required) on the specified date, time and venue, the Organiser reserves the right to forfeit the Prize and award it to the next eligible participant, as determined by the Organiser.

7. PRIZE

- 7.1. There shall be one (1) prize awarded under the Lucky Draw.
- 7.2. The prize is one (1) BYD Sealion 7 motor vehicle, or such replacement vehicle as may be provided in accordance with these terms and conditions (the “**Prize**”).
- 7.3. The Prize comprises the vehicle only and does not include any ancillary or consequential costs associated with vehicle ownership, operation or registration, unless expressly stated otherwise.
- 7.4. The colour, specifications, fittings, fixtures and accessories of the Prize shall be determined by the Sponsor at its sole discretion.
- 7.5. The Prize may differ from any image, illustration, advertisement or promotional material used in connection with the Lucky Draw.

8. PRIZE EXCLUSIONS, COE AND REGISTRATION COSTS

- 8.1. Unless expressly stated otherwise, the Prize comprises the vehicle only and does not include any ancillary or consequential costs associated with the ownership, operation, registration or collection of the Prize.
- 8.2. The Winner shall be responsible for procuring, paying and satisfying all costs, fees, taxes, charges, levies and requirements relating to the registration, collection, ownership and use of the Prize, including:
- (a) Certificate of Entitlement (“**COE**”);
 - (b) motor vehicle insurance;
 - (c) road tax;
 - (d) Vehicle Emissions Scheme surcharge, or any applicable carbon, emissions-based tax or penalty;
 - (e) servicing programme;
 - (f) In-Vehicle Unit, On-Board Unit equipment and installation costs, or any subsequent technological or physical replacement mandated under applicable law;
 - (g) Goods and Services Tax (“**GST**”) at the prevailing statutory rate at the time of supply or registration;

- (h) registration fee;
 - (i) Additional Registration Fee, including any adjustments or progressive tax bands applicable at the time of registration;
 - (j) number plate;
 - (k) any fittings, fixtures and accessories other than those provided by the Sponsor in its sole discretion; and
 - (l) any other ancillary costs, statutory fees, charges, levies, taxes or costs not expressly stated to be included as part of the Prize.
- 8.3. The Sponsor may, but is not obliged to, assist the Winner in obtaining a COE. If the Sponsor assists the Winner with obtaining a COE:
- (a) the Winner may request the Sponsor to bid for a COE on the Winner's behalf or obtain the relevant category COE by his or her own means; and
 - (b) any request for the Sponsor to bid for a COE on the Winner's behalf shall be subject to the Sponsor's prevailing terms and conditions, including payment of any applicable COE bidding deposit and applicable GST.
- 8.4. The Winner shall register the Prize within one (1) month from:
- (a) the date of announcement of the Lucky Draw result; or
 - (b) where the Prize is temporarily out of stock or temporarily unavailable and the Winner elects to wait for the Prize in accordance with Clause 10, the date on which the Sponsor notifies the Winner that the Prize is available for registration and/or collection.
- 8.5. If the Winner fails to register or collect the Prize within the applicable period, all charges for warehousing, storage, insurance and any other statutory or administrative payments due on the Prize as a result of delayed registration or collection shall be borne and paid exclusively by the Winner.
- 8.6. All payments arising from or in connection with the Prize shall be made in full before collection of the Prize.

9. PRIZE FULFILMENT AND REDEMPTION

- 9.1. For verification purposes, the Winner shall be required to present in person the following documents to the Sponsor on the scheduled appointment date and at the location determined by the Sponsor:
- (a) the original notification letter from the Organiser;
 - (b) the Winner's physical NRIC / FIN or valid work pass (e.g. Employment Pass, S Pass or Dependent Pass), whichever is applicable; and
 - (c) any other identification documents as reasonably required, including but not limited to the Winner's proof of address.

- 9.2. The Organiser shall administer the Lucky Draw, including winner notification, eligibility verification and liaison with the Winner.
- 9.3. The Sponsor shall be responsible for the registration, preparation and physical handover of the Prize, subject to the Winner completing all required documentation and paying all costs relating to the Prize.
- 9.4. After collection of the Prize, the Organiser shall handle issues relating to the Lucky Draw, and the Sponsor shall handle issues relating to the Prize.

10. TEMPORARY UNAVAILABILITY AND SUBSTITUTION OF PRIZE

- 10.1. If the Prize is temporarily out of stock or temporarily unavailable, the Sponsor shall notify the Organiser and the Winner in writing of the estimated availability timeline.
- 10.2. In such an event, the Winner may elect to wait for the Prize to be available, provided that:
 - (a) the Winner confirms such election in writing within the period notified by the Organiser and/or the Sponsor; and
 - (b) the Winner completes all registration, documentation and payment requirements within one (1) month from the date on which the Sponsor notifies the Winner that the Prize is available for registration and/or collection.
- 10.3. If the Winner does not elect to wait for the Prize within the period notified by the Organiser and/or the Sponsor, the Sponsor shall provide a replacement prize in accordance with Clause 10.4.
- 10.4. If the Prize faces severe supply chain delays, is discontinued, cannot be registered, or cannot reasonably be supplied within six (6) months from the date on which the Winner is notified of the Prize, the Sponsor shall, at its own cost and with the Organiser's prior written approval, substitute the Prize with a replacement motor vehicle of equivalent or higher retail value and specification.
- 10.5. For the avoidance of doubt, the Winner shall remain responsible for all costs relating to the Prize or any replacement prize, including any increase in COE prices, taxes, fees, charges, insurance or other costs arising from or in connection with any delay in availability, registration or collection.
- 10.6. The Organiser and the Sponsor shall not be responsible for any losses, damages, costs or expenses arising out of or in connection with any increase in COE prices, taxes, fees, charges, insurance or other costs relating to delayed delivery, registration or collection of the Prize or any replacement prize, except to the extent that such liability cannot be excluded under applicable law.

11. NO CASH ALTERNATIVE, TRANSFER OR EXCHANGE

- 11.1. The Prize cannot be exchanged for cash.
- 11.2. The Prize is not transferable, assignable or exchangeable, and may not be substituted by the Winner.
- 11.3. If the Winner is unable or unwilling to take ownership of the Prize for any reason, including where the Winner does not hold a valid driving licence, does not satisfy the minimum age requirements, or does not wish to take ownership of the Prize, the Winner may request to enter into a separate arrangement with the Sponsor for the sale of the Prize back to the Sponsor.

- 11.4. Any buy-back arrangement under Clause 11.3 shall be subject to the Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion, and shall be subject to applicable laws, regulations and contractual terms. The Sponsor shall have no obligation to agree to any buy-back arrangement, and any buy-back value shall be separately agreed between the Winner and the Sponsor.
- 11.5. No COE procurement or vehicle registration process will be required by the Winner if the Sponsor agrees to purchase the Prize from the Winner before registration.
- 11.6. If the Winner declines the Prize, fails to respond within the stipulated timeframe, fails to fulfil any eligibility or verification requirements, or does not proceed with the applicable prize acceptance, registration or buy-back process within the timeframe notified by the Sponsor, the Winner shall be deemed to have forfeited the Prize.
- 11.7. If the Prize is forfeited, the Organiser may, at its sole discretion, select an alternative winner in accordance with Clause 5. The replacement winner shall be subject to the same eligibility, verification and prize acceptance requirements as the original Winner.

12. ADDITIONAL REDEMPTION CONDITIONS

- 12.1. The Sponsor shall not impose any additional terms, conditions, restrictions or requirements on prize redemption other than those:
- (a) expressly approved in writing by the Organiser;
 - (b) consistent with these terms and conditions and any consumer-facing terms published by the Organiser; and
 - (c) mandatory under applicable Singapore law or regulatory requirements.
- 12.2. The Sponsor shall not condition prize redemption on the Winner making additional purchases, entering into unrelated agreements, or agreeing to marketing arrangements beyond those expressly agreed in writing or permitted under these terms and conditions and applicable law.

13. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 13.1. Participation in the Lucky Draw constitutes each participant's full and unconditional agreement to these terms and conditions and to the Organiser's decisions, which are final and binding in all matters relating to the Lucky Draw.
- 13.2. In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between any statement in advertising, publicity or promotional materials and these terms and conditions, these T&Cs shall prevail.
- 13.3. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify any participant who:
- (a) tampers with or attempts to tamper with the entry process or the operation of the Lucky Draw;
 - (b) submits false, inaccurate, incomplete or misleading information;
 - (c) acts fraudulently, dishonestly, disruptively or in bad faith;
 - (d) breaches these T&Cs; or
 - (e) is otherwise determined by the Organiser to be ineligible.

- 13.4. The Organiser shall not be responsible for lost, late, incomplete, inaccurate, invalid, misdirected, delayed, corrupted or undelivered entries, notifications, communications or documents, whether due to technical, human, network, system, electronic or other errors.
- 13.5. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel, suspend, modify or terminate the Lucky Draw, in whole or in part, if fraud, technical failures, system failures, legal or regulatory requirements, force majeure events or any other factor beyond the Organiser's reasonable control impairs the integrity, administration, security, fairness or proper conduct of the Lucky Draw.
- 13.6. If the Lucky Draw is cancelled, suspended, modified or terminated, the Organiser may, where practicable and subject to applicable law, select a winner from eligible entries received before the relevant event giving rise to such cancellation, suspension, modification or termination.

14. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY AND RELEASE

- 14.1. By participating in the Lucky Draw, each participant agrees that the Organiser, the Sponsor, their respective related corporations, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, agents, contractors, representatives, advertising agencies, promotion agencies and service providers (collectively, the "**Released Parties**") shall not be liable for any loss, damage, claim, cost, expense, injury or liability arising out of or in connection with:

- (a) participation in the Lucky Draw;
- (b) acceptance, possession, registration, collection, use or misuse of the Prize;
- (c) any failure, delay or inability to award, register, deliver or collect the Prize;
- (d) any technical, network, electronic, system, website, platform, communication or human error;
- (e) any change in law, regulation, tax, fee, levy, vehicle registration requirement, COE price, vehicle availability, vehicle specification or regulatory requirement; or
- (f) any act or omission of any third party,

except to the extent such liability cannot be excluded under applicable law.

- 14.2. The Released Parties are not responsible if the Lucky Draw cannot be conducted or the Prize cannot be awarded due to cancellations, delays, interruptions arising from any causes beyond their control, including acts of God, acts of civil or military authority, fires, strikes, lockouts or labour disputes, epidemics, governmental restrictions, wars, riots, earthquakes, storms, typhoons, floods and breakdowns in electronic and computer information and communications systems.
- 14.3. The Organiser shall not be liable for any faults or defects with the Prize. Any issues or queries relating to the condition of the Prize should be referred to the Sponsor.
- 14.4. Nothing in these T&Cs shall limit or exclude liability for fraud, death or personal injury caused by negligence, or any liability which cannot be excluded under applicable law.

15. PUBLICITY

- 15.1. By accepting the Prize, the Winner consents to the Organiser, the Sponsor and their respective related corporations, business partners and agents using the Winner's name, image, likeness, voice, photograph, video recording, statements and prize information in newspapers, radio, social

media and other media or platforms for winner announcement, prize presentation, publicity, sales, marketing and promotional purposes, without additional compensation and subject to applicable law.

The Winner agrees to participate in reasonable photography, filming, interview and publicity activities relating to the Lucky Draw and/or the Prize.

16. PERSONAL DATA

- 16.1. By participating in the Lucky Draw, each participant consents to the Organiser, the Sponsor and their respective related corporations, business partners, agents and service providers collecting, using and disclosing his or her personal data, including identification information and contact details, for purposes connected with the administration of the Lucky Draw, eligibility verification, winner notification, fraud prevention, audit, record-keeping, prize fulfilment and compliance with applicable law.
- 16.2. The Winner consents to the Organiser disclosing his or her personal data to the Sponsor where reasonably necessary for Prize verification, registration, delivery and fulfilment.
- 16.3. The Sponsor shall use any personal data received from the Organiser solely for the purposes for which it was disclosed, and shall comply with the Personal Data Protection Act 2012 and all applicable data protection laws.
- 16.4. Information collected from participants shall be handled in accordance with the Organiser's privacy policy, available at [<https://singaporeinternationalmarathon.com/privacy-policy/>].

17. GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTES

- 17.1. These T&Cs and the Lucky Draw, and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it, its subject matter or its formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims), shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Singapore.
- 17.2. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or in connection with these T&Cs and the Lucky Draw, or the existence, validity, breach or termination thereof, shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration in Singapore administered by the Singapore International Arbitration Centre in accordance with the Arbitration Rules of the SIAC for the time being in force.
- 17.3. The seat of the arbitration shall be in Singapore. The tribunal shall consist of one (1) arbitrator, to be appointed in accordance with the SIAC Rules. The language of the arbitration shall be English.

18. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of these terms and conditions is held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, that provision shall be deemed deleted to the extent necessary, and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

19. OFFICIAL TERMS AND WINNER INFORMATION
